MAY 17th – INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST
HOMOPHOBIA, TRANSPHOBIA AND BIPHOBIA

- WHEREAS** May 17th as the International Day against Homophobia, Transphobia and Biphobia was created in 2004
- WHEREAS** In under a decade, May 17 has established itself the single most important date for LGBTI communities to mobilize on a worldwide scale
- WHEREAS** The Day represents an annual landmark to draw the attention of decision makers, the media, the public, opinion leaders and local authorities to the alarming situation faced by lesbian, gay, bisexuals, transgender and intersex people and all those who do not conform to majority sexual and gender norms
- WHEREAS** The date of May 17th is now celebrated by more than 130 countries
- NOW THEREFORE** I, Mayor Jeff Cantwell, of the Town of Wolfville, do hereby proclaim **May 17, 2016** to be observed as **“International Day Against Homophobia, Transphobia and Biphobia”** in the Town of Wolfville.
