MOTIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS FROM COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE, FEBRUARY 6, 2018

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN, CHANGE 2

- Council approved Change 2 to the Town of Wolfville's Emergency Management Plan, effective February 20, 2018 (Available on the [Town's of Wolfville's Emergency Preparedness Website](#))

MPS/LUB AMENDMENTS – 329 MAIN STREET

- Council gave First Reading to the Municipal Planning Strategy and Land Use Bylaw Amendments, as attached to RFD 007-2018, to re-designate and re-zone portions of the 329 Main Street property, as outlined in the resolution, and forward to the March 20, 2018 Public Hearing and Town Council meeting for second reading

PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION POLICY UPDATE

- Council approved the following changes to [Policy 140-014](#)
 - Schedule A amended to provide Wolfville Historical Society relief from all area rates, except fire protection rate
 - Schedule C amended to remove St George's Lodge, Gaspereau Avenue property
- Council repealed Policy 140-008

THREE PHASE POWER MPS AMENDMENT

- Council approved amending Motion 40-03-17 to read that Council approve giving second reading to the Municipal Planning Strategy amendment as outlined in Resolution 2 – Attachment 2 to RFD 010-2017 that Policies 8.4.4(c) and 13.4.5 be removed from the Municipal Planning Strategy which would allow overhead (above ground) power and communication infrastructure

INSURANCE

- Council authorized staff to renew the Town's Insurance requirements for the next two fiscal years (2018/19 and 2019/20) with the UNSM endorsed plan as provided by MCTI/Frank Cowan Company

REGIONAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORGANIZATION (REMO)

- Council approved becoming a signatory to the REMO Intermunicipal Services Agreement (2018) with the Town of Berwick, Town of Kentville, Town of Wolfville and Municipality of the County of Kings, having in place a Regional Emergency Management Organization in place by April 1, 2018

VWRM DEBT GUARANTEE – DEBENTURE TERM RENEWAL

- Council approved the Guarantee Resolution in the amount of \$12,102, covering the Town's share of the long-term debt funding required for Debenture 33-A-1 Balloon Payment Financing for Valley Waste Resource Management

KINGS TRANSIT AUTHORITY 2018/19 BUDGET

- Council did not approve the Kings Transit Authority 2018/19 Operating & Capital Budgets as presented at the February 20th Town Council meeting
