Notable Investigations

March 9thst – June 1st

March 2018

- Male and female involved in domestic assault. Male charged
- Female reported theft of car. Investigation revealed she forgot where she had parked the car.
- Vehicle left Subway and observed driving erratically. Alcohol readings of 110mg% were taken, Driver charged with Impaired Driving.
- Vehicle found parked the wrong way on Acadia Street. Driver noted to have been drinking. Alcohol readings of 110mg% taken, Driver charged with Impaired Driving.
- Vehicle Checkpoint conducted on Gaspereau Ave and vehicle came through checkpoint and found to be drinking. Alcohol readings of 120mg% taken and driver charged with Impaired Driving.

April 2018

- Two males reported to be going door to door selling alarm systems. Did not provide ID and acting suspicious. Males were not located.
- Male operating a vehicle while drivers licence suspended.
- Male reports his daughter was highly intoxicated, requested police attend. Female arrested and lodged in cells until sober.
- 19 year old male was assaulted by being punched in the face by his girlfriend's 31 year old brother. Charges laid.
- 21 year old female scammed out of \$500.00 by individual posing as CRA and demanded \$500.00 in iTunes gift cards. Female provided the iTunes numbers to the suspect.

May 2018

- 78 year old male charged with threatening to return to a business with a shotgun over a money transfer issue.
- Vehicle stolen from owner's driveway on Acadia Street. Investigation still ongoing.
- 43 year old mother was reported to be intoxicated and fighting with her 12 year old son. Mother was arrested for assault and charged.
- 49 year old male was arrested and charged with assaulting a 49 year old male (Acadia Security) at the Axe Lounge at Acadia.
- 20 year old male was arrested and charged with causing a disturbance at the Anvil after being removed by the bouncers. Male attempted to re-enter the business and became physical.

School Resource Officer

Kings District once again has two School Resource Officers to service all schools in the county after there had been a recent transfer. Cst. Jennifer BRITTON has been at the Wolfville School working on Safe School plans and communicating with them for any needs.

Street Crime Enforcement Unit

The Street Crime Unit continues to investigate a number of investigations resulting in the execution of search warrants and the seizure of drugs throughout the county.
