Notable Investigations

- **June 8th** – 15 year old male arrested and charged after pulling a knife on a sibling.
- **April 23rd** - 52 year old male and 72 year old male arrested and charge for breaking and entering a local laundromat after extensive investigation involving the Kings Street Crime Unit and General Investigation section.
- 27 year old male and 36 year old male charged with illegally transporting cannabis in a vehicle under the Cannabis Control Act.
- **June** - Ongoing investigation of Extortion at the Acadia University campus involving computer crimes.
- **May 5th** – RCMP required to assist EHS with gaining access to a residence after elderly female was bleeding from her leg and could not access the door.
- Kings RCMP Transported a male back from Montreal who was wanted on numerous charges are warrants through Kings County via the RCMP Air Services. (Theft of vehicles, Fraud, thefts etc)
