

Employment Opportunity: Summer Student GIS Technician



The Town of Wolfville is inviting applications for the position of Summer Student Geographic Information System (GIS) Technician. This is a three-month term position for the 2021 summer season.

The Wolfville GIS has played an important part in the Town becoming a smart community and provides a variety of data driven information services through our web portal and is a tool for the organization when making capital and operational planning decisions across all departments. Notable GIS application projects include Asset Management Inventory, Planning Development Information System, Bylaw Compliance, and Permit Process Tracking. This term position will report to the Lead GIS Technician.

The Technician will provide support in the collection, enhancement, and distribution of information that supports the Public Works Infrastructure Asset Management Plan. The successful candidate may take on other duties as assigned. The position is 35 hours per week, Monday to Friday, 8.30 am to 4.30 pm.

Candidates will have an accredited technical certificate in GIS or be working towards successfully completing their certificate within their first or second year of enrollment. The candidate must be proficient in the use of ESRI's suite of GIS products and previous experience using ArcGIS Collector and ArcGIS Online is an asset. Previous experience working in a municipal government is an asset.
