## Do you qualify for the Property Tax Exemption of \$1,040 for 2024-25?

- The combined gross income of all persons living on the property must be \$45,000 or less. We will require a copy of your 2023 Notice of Assessment from Canada Revenue Agency showing line 15000 Total Income (for each person).
- You must be the registered owner of the property and live in the house as your primary residence.
